

# RRSA Board Meeting Minutes

February 10, 2026

Meeting was called to order at 6:04pm.

- 1) Coaches introduced themselves and shared their previous playing and coaching experience. Coaches received a copy of the rules for the draft, Carol reviewed the rules.
- 2) **Subs:** We now have 20+ on the sub list, vs. 2 last year. Seniors are allowed to sub in coed games. It was suggested that subs make their availability known to the coaches. Jim Hupp reported that after paying dues and being on the sub list, he did not play in a game. Will discuss at next meeting how to handle this situation.
