SUGAR GROVE PARK DISTRICT MENS LEAGUE RULES Winter 2024

General:

- 1. All deposits and league fees are NON-refundable
- 2. Insurance is **NOT** provided by the Sugar Grove Park District; players participate at their own risk

Captains Responsibilities:

- All captains are expected to inform their players concerning all rules and regulations prior to the first game
- It is the captain's responsibility to make sure ALL fees are paid, waivers are signed and roster is correct
- 3. Captains are responsible for the conduct of their players and any team spectators.

Roster/Player Eligibility:

- 1. Roster limit is 15 players
- 2. All players must be at LEAST 21 years of age
- 3. Completed roster **MUST** be submitted by the start of each teams first game
- 4. A player cannot play on more than one team in the same league
- 5. Players can be added **BEFORE** week 4; rosters lock after week 4 has begun for any given team

Referees:

- 1. The Sugar Grove Park District will assign up to 2 IHSA officials for each game
- 2. All tournament games will include 2 IHSA officials

Uniforms:

1. Teams are required to wear the **SAME** colored shirts **WITH** a number; this makes it easier for the officials to call fouls during the game

Playing Rules:

- All officials AND players are to adhere to IHSA rules in addition to the Sugar Grove Park District league rules
- 2. Games will be played with two 20 minute halves
- 3. The clock will always be running with exception to the LAST MINUTE of the FIRST HALF as well as the LAST 2 MINUTES of the SECOND HALF
- Gametime is starting time unless games are running behind; forfeit is called 10 minutes AFTER the scheduled start time
- 5. Each team gets 2 one minute time outs per **HALF**; additionally each team gets a single one minute timeout during each overtime
- Overtime will be 3 minutes in length; the clock will only STOP during the LAST
 MINUTE of the overtime period
- 7. A player with 2 technical fouls in a single game WILL BE EJECTED
- 8. 4 PLAYERS on a on single team ARE REQUIRED to start a game; a team MUST have 3 PLAYERS on the court AT ALL TIMES

Suspensions:

- 1. Threatening officials, scorekeepers or supervisors; any players who pushes, strikes or touches one of the 3 will result in a **SUSPENSION** from the league
- 2. Under the influence of drugs/alcohol; 2 game suspension for the player
- 3. Foul language; first offense = team warning; second offense = technical foul
