



## 6U T-Ball

### Games

- Time limit 1:10 or 4 innings, whichever comes first
- Game sites subject to change | Base length: 45-50 feet

### Pitching

- Each coach will pitch to their own team – may pitch from as close or far back as desired.
- No walks or strikeouts.
- Coaches may choose to not pitch to a player who may not be ready and go straight to the tee.

### Batting

- Half the lineup will bat each inning. This keeps the game moving.
- Batter will be allowed a maximum of 3 pitches from coach to put the ball in play.
- If third pitch is fouled off, one more pitch will be allowed.
- If ball is still not put in play, tee will be set out.
- Batter will be allowed 3 swings off tee.
- On the final attempt, the ball goes foul, the batter is out.
- The ball must travel 10 feet (coach discretion) from home plate in fair territory.
- Every player must be included in the batting order the entire game. Late arrivals may be added.

### Base running

- No lead-offs or stealing will be allowed.
- No bases on overthrow.

### Defense

- All players should play. Teams should be limited to 7 players in the infield/dirt with additional players in the outfield grass.
