## Choosing Your Events

Each event on the list is a separate event. Therefore, Men's Soccer and Co-ed Soccer are considered two SEPARATE event selections.

Companies can enter a maximum of 3 teams per event: each team counting as an event selection. SO if you register 3 Men's Bowling Teams, each team counts as one of your chosen events for the games.

Example: A Division I team who chooses to enter 3 Bowling teams, would then have 7 events left to fill.

As a side note—your overall possible Corporate Cup point total is lowered when you enter more than one team into an event. For example: instead of having three possible 10-point (1st place) winners (in 3 separate events) you would only have the possibility of one 10-point winner (1st), one 8-point finisher (2nd) and one 6-point finisher (3rd) if you entered 3 teams.

**OPEN:** If an event is classified as open (not Co-ed, men's or women's) then either gender may fill the roster.

**CO-ED:** Events classified as Co-ed have a specific number of male to female ratio on the playing surface. These ratios are in the Rule Book.

# Entry Fees

## Division Entry Fees:

Division I - (up to 250 employees):	\$725 select 10 Events
Division II - (251-400 employees):	\$925 select 14 Events
Division III - (401-500 employees):	\$1125 select 18 Events
<b>NEW!</b> Division IV - (over 501 employees):	<b>\$1125 select 18 Events</b>
<b>NEW!</b> Small Company Division* - Less than 100 employees:	<b>\$375 select 3-5 events</b>

*\*will compete with Division 1 Teams*

## Specific Event Fees:

Some events require additional participation fees to be paid at the time of registration:

Golf	\$40 per player (4 man team = \$160) - includes cart
Paintball	\$20 per player (4 man team = \$80)
Go Kart	\$25 per racer (4 man team = \$100)
Pistol Shoot	\$5 per shooter (2 man team = \$10)
Rifle Shoot	\$5 per shooter (3 man team = \$15)
Trap Shoot	\$15 per shooter

(Div 1: 2 shooters = \$30, Div 2: 3 shooters = \$45, Div 3/4: 4 shooters = \$60)

## YOU CAN ADD EVENTS

If your company has already selected its allotted number of events, but you still have teams that wish to compete—you can add Events. Additional Events do not count toward the Corporate Cup and must be designated as additional Events in advance of the Games.

### **ADDITIONAL EVENT FEES:**

\$75 each for most events plus any additional specific event fee as listed above.
