Game Day: Games will begin the week of April 3rd. Start times are at 6:30, 7:30,

8:30, and 9:30 PM at all parks except Bingham Junction that will begin at 6:00, 7:00, 8:00, and 9:00 PM. Game times will vary from week-to-week and will be spread out as evenly as possible across all teams throughout the season, so you

don't have all early games or all late games.

Rosters: We will be using the online roster system through our Quickscores website at

www.quickscores.com/sportsoffice. Information on how to register as a manager and create your roster is located on the adult softball league tab on the website. You will be able to input your roster one week prior to your first game once your schedule is posted. All team managers will need to hit the print waiver button and bring it to the first league game. All team members will need to sign the printed waiver form before playing in any game. For any

additions or emergency adds after the first week contact your league supervisor.

<u>Uniforms:</u> Each team must wear uniforms. All uniforms must have at least a 6-inch number on the back in a contrasting color to the shirt. Identical numbers are not allowed.

Teams must also meet 1 of these 2 requirements: 1) Uniforms will be the same color or, 2) Uniforms may be a different color but must have the team logo on

the front. The deadline for having uniforms is by your team's 4th game.

Equipment: SLCO will provide two new game balls for each game (coed leagues are no

longer using an 11-inch ball and will be playing with a 12-inch ball). Each team is in-charge of retrieving foul balls and home run balls and/or providing extra game balls in the case of a lost ball. Bats must be stamped 1.20 or less B.P.F. for USSSA., ASA, NSA, etc. Bats must have the USSSA, ASA, USA or NSA stamp on

its taper or be a wood bat. Cleats, if worn, must be plastic (no metal spikes).

league game.
