II. Team Guidelines:

Entry Fee:

Entry fee is \$95 per player. Fee waiver (free lunch) policy states that qualifying participants will receive scholarships for half of the registration fee. Rosters:

Each team must carry a minimum of 12 and a maximum of 14 players. Official rosters are due by November 25th, 2014.

Player

Eligibility: Each player must be currently enrolled in the ninth grade at a

Jordan School District Middle School and play <u>only</u> for the school he or she attends. Each player must have a grade point average of 2.0 or above and no more than one "F" in the grading period prior to playing in the Jordan 9th Grade Basketball League. Coaches should submit team rosters to the school for grade verification immediately following tryouts and after each grading period during the season. If a player does not meet the required scholastic eligibility, then they will be dismissed from

the team and there will be no refunds.

Coaches: The Jordan School District and/or Salt Lake County will select

the basketball coaches at each Middle School. Salt Lake County

will pay each coach \$525 per basketball season.

III. Season Schedule:

Contact School: Each coach should make contact with the school principal or

2014.

Practice

Guidelines: No organized practices or tryouts will be permitted prior to
