SHOTGUN RANGE RULES

Safe firearm handling practices are required here at the Lee Kay Public Shooting Range. Enjoyable experiences demand it, lives depend on it. Your compliance is appreciated by our staff, volunteers, and guests.

- A. Carry all uncased firearms with the **action open** and the muzzle pointed in a safe direction.
- B. **ALL shooters must check in at the office.**
- C. ONLY 7 ½, 8, or 9, maximum of 1,300 feet per second, shot size on all fields.
- D. NO slugs, buckshot or home defense loads.
- E. Shoulder fired shotguns only!
- F. Actions open until your turn to shoot.
- G. ONE shot for one bird on trap.
- H. Only load ONE shell in your firearm for trap (the only exception is doubles).
- I. Skeet and 5-Stand – **no more than** two shells in your firearm.
- J. Hearing and eye protection is required for everyone while on the range whether shooting or observing. On “the range” is considered north of the sidewalk.

When the cone is on top of the house, it is either being loaded or worked on. *Please step back from the line and open your action.*

- K. Alcoholic beverages are NOT allowed at the Lee Kay Public Shooting Range.
- L. Speed limit 10 mph.
- M. Pets must be on a leash at all times.
- N. Youth under 16 must be under adult supervision.
- O. Smoking is not allowed on the ranges.
- P. No steel shot on the patterning board! Stand-ups and cardboard are available for patterning steel shot.

- Please pick up empty hulls and boxes.
