- 15 Minutes of Warm up and drills followed by 40 Minutes of Game Play

PROGRAM FORMAT

- 1. Players will play with the same team each week.
- 2. There will be a focus on fun and exposing the children to the game of baseball.
- 3. Game play will be played with even teams. Players will rotate defensive positions every batter.
- 4. Each team will roster bat and then switch sides. Base Runners will advance one base when the next player puts the ball in play.
- 5. At this age parents are encouraged to get involved. Likely, this is your child's first exposure to organized team sports. Talk with your coach about how you can assist to make this a positive experience for your child.

COVID GUIDELINES

- 1. Child/self monitoring and assessment before each game
 - In the past 14 days have you experienced:
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Fever (100.4 degrees or higher)
 - Chills
 - Repeated shaking with chills
 - Muscle pain
 - Headache
 - Sore throat
 - New loss of taste or smell
- 2. Frequent hand washing or hand sanitizing
 - All children will be required to hand sanitize at the start of each quarter

- Hand sanitizer will be available inside the YMCA Facility
- 3. YMCA staff, coaches, spectators, and volunteers are required to wear masks
 - Children 10 and over are required to wear masks when not in play and unable to practice social distance
- 4. Distance yourselves between other families
- 5. If a positive COVID-19 case is reported and traced back to our YMCA, we will cooperate fully with guidance given to us by our local health department.

OTHER INFO

- 1. Players should not share any snacks, food, or beverage with one another.
- 2. All players should bring their own labeled water bottle. Our drinking fountains are not in operation during COVID.
- 3. Vending machines: located inside the main lobby. Accepts card, Apple/Samsung pay, exact cash/coin.
- 4. All spectators are required to wear masks while inside the YMCA facility.
- 5. Everyone should practice social distancing.
