

**BEREA FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH
2021 GYM SAFETY GUIDELINES**

Please do NOT enter our facility if you are showing any signs of sickness such as but not limited to, fever, cough, fatigue, smell and taste loss. Also any person who should be quarantined is asked to not enter the facility.

Please enter through the Gym Lobby doors only. Doors will open 10 minutes prior to game time. Hand sanitizers are available for all guests, please use upon entering.

Face coverings are required for all spectators at all times while inside our facilities. Children under 6 do not have to wear a face covering.

Spectators are expected to social distance while inside facilities, seated or standing. Seating areas will be marked off. Please stay inside of these areas only. **Attendance will be limited to 2 people per player, until full capacity is reached.** Full capacity will be when approximately 35% of seated area has been reached. We ask all family groups to sit together.

The church reserves the right to determine full safe seating capacity or if social distancing is not being appropriately maintained. Spectators may be asked to move to comply with social distancing protocols.

Spectators are to remain seated during the games, unless using the restroom. All non-playing children are to remain seated with parents.

Restrooms will be available. Capacity of no more than 2 people at a time. Please wait outside if the restroom is full. When visiting restrooms, face coverings must be worn.

No food or drinks will be permitted inside the gym other than player water bottles. Water fountains are not available.

Spectators will not be allowed on the court following games. Please exit the gym immediately from inside the gym, not the lobby.

Face coverings are required for all coaches and players upon entry and exit from the facility but not during games. Please social distance when in team huddles or along team bench areas.

Warm-up basketballs will not be provided; coaches need to bring team warm-up balls and secure during games. Coaches are responsible for sanitizing their warm-up balls.

Hand sanitizers will be available at the scorer's table for referees, coaches, and athletes use; please sanitize hands often.

Please help space players while seated on the team bench. Have the players to remain in the marked area to check into the game, do not come to the scorer's table. Coaches, please stay in your team area, do not walk any further down the court at any time.

Coaches, please take players outside of the gym for post-game talks; then deliver players to parents outside of the facility.

Anyone failing to comply with these guidelines may be asked to leave the facility.

You are entering of your own free will and it is your responsibility to follow the guidelines set by the CDC, State of South Carolina and therefore required and followed by Berea First Baptist Church/Wade Hampton Church Basketball League to ensure the health and safety of EVERYONE in this facility.
