



## **2020-2021 Fairview Basketball Guidelines**

### **For Practice & Game Day**

#### **Spectators/Players**

- Entering & leaving: All players & spectators should wear mask.
- Face coverings are required for ALL spectators if social distancing cannot be met.
- Social distancing is required by all depending on spacing at gym. Please sit as a family if possible.
- Only 2 spectators are encouraged this season for each player, excluding siblings. Due to Covid-19 concerns, we always ask for all parents to keep their children with them.
- Spectators should remain in their seats during game unless going to restroom. Only one person allowed in restrooms at a time.
- Hand sanitizers stations will be available at gym.
- NO spectators are allowed on the playing court at any time.
- Spectators, coaches, and players must leave the gym (through exit) immediately after the game.
- Spectators, coaches, and players should NOT arrive no earlier than 10 minutes before scheduled game time.

#### **Water**

- Water will not be provided at games. Players need to bring their own water bottle. NO sharing!

#### **Score Table/Bench Area**

- Bench will be spread out and cleaned after each game.
- Table personnel will be the only one allowed at the table.
- Face coverings must be worn.

#### **Basketballs**

- Each team must provide their own warm-ups balls this season.
- Game balls will be wiped or sprayed as much as possible throughout the day.
- Coaches clean practice basketballs after each practice.

# **Safety FIRST!**

### Pre & Post Game

- NO handshakes, fist bumps, etc. before or after the game.
- Pre-game prayer this season will take place at half-court with each team in a line facing each other, but 10 feet apart (NO circle). Pre-game prayer to be led by the home team.

### Coaches

- Coaches are encouraged to wear face coverings for the duration of practice & games.
- Coaches and Officials will meet pre-game to discuss any rules or questions. NO handshakes, fist bumps, etc.

### Officials

- Officials are encouraged to wear face coverings unless on the game court.
- Officials will be required to use the New electronic whistle which allows no exchange of fluids from a normal whistle. Fairview will provide at scorers' table.
- Coaches and Officials will meet pre-game to discuss any rules or questions. NO handshakes, fist bumps, etc.
- Officials will be responsible to report to Fairview sports staff any incidents that occur before, during, and after games.

### Concessions

- No concessions will be allowed this season.

**You are entering of your own free will and it is your responsibility to follow the guidelines set by the CDC, State of South Carolina and therefore required and followed by Fairview Baptist Church/Wade Hampton Church Basketball League to ensure the health and safety of not only you and your family but all others in this facility.**

### Protocol for Positive Covid-19 Results

1. If any player, coach, or gym staff who has tested positive for Covid-19, **MUST** notify Dean Hawkins @ 864-350-1452 or church office (877-1881) immediately.
2. Fairview staff will notify the other church representative/staff, host gym personnel, and officials immediately concerning the positive test results, **NO** personal information will be shared, only the team involved. It will then be their responsibility to notify their coaches, players, and parents immediately.
3. The individual testing positive will not be allowed to participate in practices or games until they have adhered to CDC guidelines for quarantine period.
4. The Fairview Sports Staff has adopted this policy to make sure that all participants can play this season with safety "FIRST" in mind.

# Do you have any of the following symptoms?

- Fever greater than 100.4 degree.
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing.
- Cough
- Chills
- Repeated shaking with chills.
- Muscle pain not known to be caused by physical activity.
- Sore Throat
- New loss of taste or smell.

**If any person (member) is found to have a fever or other symptoms outlined by the CDC, he/she will not be allowed into the building.**
