

Special safety rules for basketball 2021 Season

Game Day in the St. Giles Gym

- **Spectators will be limited to 2 family members per player.** (Assumes 10 players per team with two coaches each) Signs will be placed on each door marking entrance, attendee limits and the exits. All league communications to member churches will feature the St. Giles seating limitations in hopes of avoiding confrontations at the door.
- Hand sanitation station available at the entrance.
- Attendees will enter through one door and exit through another at game conclusion. ***We will use a PA system to announce to fans how to exit the building and to exit immediately at the conclusion of the game.***
- All spectators will be asked to wear masks and to array themselves upon bleachers as indicated by markings. We will stagger seating
- Bench area will be designated and arrayed vertically instead of the usual horizontal fashion (four on lower bench, three on middle tier and three on upper tier etc.)
- ***Temperatures will be taken***
- ***We will have a sign at entrance with appropriate language about not entering if not feeling well etc.***
- Gym equipment will be cleaned between games along with high touch areas like restrooms and door handles. It is anticipated that this will require 15 minutes or more between games and will require that guests wait outside until finished. Spectators will be asked remain in their cars until the gym is ready to avoid groups congregating at the door.
