Covid-19 Policies

Players and Spectators

- Entering and leaving: players and spectators should wear masks when entering and leaving the facility. Once seated and social distance is in place, mask can be removed.
- Players and spectators should arrive no sooner than 10 minutes before game time. The gym will be disinfected before each game. Players and spectators will not be allowed in until this process is completed.
- Each player will be allowed 1 "family unit" at games and practices. A family unit consist of parents and sibling only.
- Spectators need to remain in their seat during the game unless going to restroom.
- Children will not be allowed to run around. Children need to remain seated with their guardian.

Facility

- The scorer's table will be six feet from the nearest player bench. There will be a designated area on each side of the scorer's table for players to check in.
 - All substitutions must come from the scorer's table not the bench.
 - Scorekeepers will disinfect game balls
- Taylor's Gym will be disinfected before and after each game.

Commonly touched areas such as; balls, tables, chairs, door handles, sink and toilet handles, etc. will be disinfected.
- Each spectator/family unit will sit together on the top and bottom corner of the bleachers. Taylor's bleachers will accommodate 4 family units per bleacher.
- If you are experiencing fever, cough, fatigue, shortness of breath or any COVID symptom – please do not enter our facility.

Game Play

- No overtime.
- Timeouts:
 - K4 – 5th Grade teams will receive 2 time outs per game
 - 6th Grade – Adult teams will receive 3 time outs per game.
- Pre-game prayer will be two lines of players facing each other with proper social distancing. No handshakes, fist bumps, holding hands, etc.
- Each team must provide their own warm up balls. Taylor's Gym will only provide game balls.
- Players will be asked to wear masks when sitting on the bench.
- Fifteen minutes will be added to scheduled game time in order to allow for disinfecting.
