

2nd & 3rd Girls Basketball 2021

West Haven/Roy Rules (9/30/2021)

1. All players must be registered, and fee paid, to be eligible to participate.
2. This is a beginner league designed to improve the basic skills of all players. Teams will play 8 regular season games. **NO POST-SEASON TOURNAMENT**. All players will receive an award for participation.
3. 9 foot goals will be used. Intermediate women's (28.5) ball will be used.
4. Games will consist of two 20 minute halves with running clock. The clock will stop on whistles the last minute of each half unless the score difference is 15 points or greater. **There is no overtime period.** Games that end regulation time tied, will be declared a tie.
5. Teams must have 4 players (minimum) to start game. A 5 minute grace period will be allowed if 4 players are not present. If team does not have 4 players before 5 minute grace period ends, game will be declared a forfeit.
6. Three Point shots count.
7. Man and zone defenses are allowed.
8. If the score is more than a 15 point spread, the score-keeper will only keep the score in the books. The team that is ahead will be asked to move back into the key area and play a defense that starts and stays inside the key.
9. No full court pressing, except for the last minute of the 2nd half.
10. Two time-outs per half. You cannot carry over unused time-outs.
11. Any coach, player or spectator, who is ejected for unsportsmanlike conduct, will not be allowed to participate for the remainder of the game and may have to sit out the following week's game if Recreation Director deems necessary or banned from the league. If a player/coach is ejected from 2 games during the season they will be expelled from the league.
12. A player cannot play on two teams in one division. A player may play on 2 teams but they must be in two different divisions. Example: A 3rd grader can play on a 2nd/3rd grade team and 4th/5th grade team.
13. A player is only allowed to play up 1 grade. Example: A 2nd grader will not be allowed to play in the 4th/5th grade league but a 3rd grader would be allowed to.
14. Only Two coaches are allowed on the bench and only one coach is allowed to stand up and coach. As soon as two coaches are up off the bench coaching and/or complaining to officials; there may be a technical foul called. If a technical foul is issued on any of the coaching staff or bench personnel, the head coach must sit on the bench the remainder of the game, and no assistant coach may stand and take the head coach's place. See Rule 10 section 5 and 6 of the NFHS Basketball Rule Book.
15. Any coach who receives a technical foul this season is subject to suspension/expulsion from the league (Recreation Director's discretion). Any coach who receives (3) technical fouls in a season will have a mandatory one game suspension. Technical fouls do not have to be committed in the same game or consecutive games for this rule to apply. If a coach receives (4) technical fouls in a season he/she is subject to another game suspension and/or will be expelled from the league (Recreation Director's discretion) and will not allowed in the gym for the remainder of the season. NFHS technical foul rules still apply (if a coach receives 2 technical fouls in a game, the coach is ejected from the game and will face possible suspension (Recreation Director's discretion) from the next game).
