

Academic Eligibility

It is the goal of the Waldport Junior League Sports Association to have players achieve the highest possible in athletics, as well as academics. We want parents and players to understand the importance of receiving good grades in school. The Oregon School Activities Association and the Lincoln County Activities Association see it as a privilege to participate in athletics during attendance at a LCSD middle or high school. In order for a student to be eligible to participate they must maintain a grade point average of 2.0 or higher and do not have any F's. Students who receive a failing grade (F) or fall below 2.0 GPA at any semester or regular interim progress grading period shall participate in a program of assistance. Any student who receives more than one failing grade (F) at any grading period will remain ineligible until the next semester or regular interim progress grading period in which they meet eligibility requirements.

Waldport Junior League Sports Association would like to begin to recognize academic eligibility at the middle school levels. It is our goal to encourage and support players to do well in academics. We as an association would like to make parents aware of the importance of academic and athletic achievements at the middle and high school levels. For example, year-end grades for 5/6th, 8th, and 11th grade grades will be the grades that will be looked at for academic eligibility. If an incoming freshman wanted to play football in the fall and had at least a 2.0 GPA, and had one F they would be placed on a program of assistance. If they received below a 2.0 and had more than one F they would be ineligible until the next semester or regular interim progress grading period in which they meet the eligibility requirements.

As an association we are committed to educating parents and athletes on the eligibility once a student reaches middle and high school. Often enough a student has wanted to go out for middle or high school fall sports only to find out they did not have the required academic qualifications.
