

OUTDOOR SPORTS WEATHER GUIDELINES



The Sports Director will make a decision on games to ensure children have the safest play environment possible. Game time decisions will be made at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled game time when possible. Updates will be posted on Playerspace. Pabst Farms families can also call the Sports Information and Weather Hotline (262–719–0308). Coaches are asked to use these guidelines in determining practice conditions/cancellations. Please contact your Sports Director with any other questions you may have.

Inclement Weather

Coaches are asked to use these guidelines in determining practice conditions/cancellations.

For practices:

- If thunder is heard or lightning is seen within 10 miles, the area will be cleared.
- All participants and spectators should evacuate from the location and will need to move indoors or to their vehicles.
- Activities will resume a minimum of 30 minutes from the last observed thunder or lightning.
- In the case of inclement weather, coaches will do their best to make appropriate decisions regarding weather cancellations. Fields may be deemed unplayable based on current weather and field conditions.

For games:

YMCA Staff will monitor weather at game sites and make the final determination on return to play.
