



Game Rescheduling Process

The purpose of this policy is to establish a fair, consistent, and transparent process for rescheduling league games while respecting the time and commitments of all teams, volunteers, officials, and facilities.

Rescheduling Request Timeline

- All rescheduling requests must be submitted at least 3 days in advance of the scheduled game times for ages 8 & Under.
- All rescheduling requests must be submitted at least 7 days in advance of the scheduled game times for ages 9 & Above.
- Requests submitted less than the times identified above, may not be considered.
- Additional fees may be assessed for late changes due to facility rental and game official costs.

Rescheduling Options

1. Game Swap with Another Team

- Teams may arrange to switch game dates with another team scheduled to play the same opponent.
- Once both teams agree, email sportsinfo@ymcaokc.org with all affected teams copied and include full details of the change.

2. Mutual Agreement with Opposing Team

- Contact the opposing coach to request a new game date and time.
- If both teams agree:
 - Contact sportsinfo@ymcaokc.org to request available game dates/times.
 - The YMCA will provide options for both teams to review and confirm.
- If a mutually agreed-upon date cannot be reached, the game will be played as originally scheduled.

No-Show & Forfeit

Definition of a No-Show

- A team is considered a no-show if they are unable to field the minimum number of players and are not ready to begin play within 10 minutes of the scheduled game time.

Forfeit Guidelines

- If a team does not meet the minimum player requirement within the 10-minute grace period, the game will be declared a forfeit.
- The opposing team will be awarded a win.

Sportsmanship & Participation Option

- If both teams are present but one team is short players, coaches may mutually agree to play a scrimmage-style game for participation and development purposes. However, the game will still be recorded as a forfeit in official standings.
- Length of scrimmage will be determined by YMCA Sports Leadership.
- When possible, officials will be provided for the scrimmage time.

Additional Notes

- Rescheduled Games will become final once posted to the online schedule
- Teams may not play more than 2 games in a day (exception tournaments)
- Games may not be stacked (ex. 2 games every other week)
- Rescheduling Games cannot create multiple Bye Weeks for Opponent
- Tournament Games are unable to be rescheduled
- Requests are not guaranteed
- YMCA will reschedule weather cancellations following our Sports Weather Policy
- YMCA will have final decision in approving all reschedule requests
